## Welcome cocktail and opening dinner

(Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> May at 7.30 pm)

**Palazzo Bovara** is the work of Francesco Soave of Ticino. It is one of the most famous neoclassical palaces in Lombardy.



Between 1797 and 1799; it was home to later French Embassy. In the year 1800 Stendhal, second lieutenant of the 6<sup>th</sup> Dragons of Napoleon's army, lived in the palace.

After the Second World War, the palazzo was restored by the architect Portaluppi. Today, Palazzo Bovara hosts many important events in Milan.

## Congress dinner

(Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> May at 8.00 pm)

The Congress dinner will be held at the Hotel Principe di Savoia, one of the world's most luxuriously appointed hotels, located in the city centre of Milan.

The hotel's landmark neoclassical building has been the natural home for international travelers and cosmopolitan society since the 1920's.



## Tours

### Classical Milan walk

(Afternoon of Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> May 2008)

The guided tour of Milan will give you the opportunity to discover Navigli district with its famous canals, the monumental cemetery, il Duomo (cathedral) and the Galleria Emanuele II and finally the museum of Teatro alla Scala.



### Lake Como

(Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> May 2008, all day including lunch)

Departure by car from Atahotel Quark to visit the city of Como. In the morning, visit to the Cavour's place, close to the lake with its exceptional panoramic views. Then, a visit to the Dome and the San Abbondio basilica, followed by lunch in the Il Soloto Post restaurant, with its beautiful garden. The day concludes with a cable car tour of the lakes and houses of Brunate.



### Historical Milan walk

Departure by car from the Atahotel Quark to visit San Lorenzo Maggiore and Sforzeco castle (castle of the Sforza family). This imposing edifice is home to works from the Middle Ages and the Renaissance, in particular, the last work of Michael Angelo, the Pieta Rondanini.
